



Join us for a capital tour

Jackson Energy will begin accepting applications on January 1, 2012, for the Jackson Energy Washington Youth Tour. Join youth from across the U.S. in Washington, D. C., for an action-packed week in June to tour the nation's capital and also learn how your government works. Jackson Energy will sponsor four (4) students who are in transition from their junior to senior year of high school. Sign up today to be eligible.

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

1. Winning applicants will be selected from eight (8) finalists in an essay contest. The subject for the essay is "Why I Would Like to Visit Washington, D.C." and should be no less than 500 words and no more than 1,200 words. Jackson Energy will provide additional information once the application has been received, and it has been verified that the student's parent or guardian is a member of the electric cooperative. The deadline for the essay to be returned to the Jackson Energy office is March 1, 2012.
2. Applicants shall be in their junior year of high school during the 2011-2012 school year. Applicants, their parents or legal guardian must be a cooperative member with their primary residence or business served by the cooperative.
3. The eight (8) finalists will be selected to attend the Frankfort Youth Tour, which will include a day-long tour of Frankfort and visits to appropriate state government sites.
4. Applicants must not be a member of the immediate family of an employee or director of Jackson Energy. Immediate family is defined as a child of an employee or director.
5. Youth Tour Winners will be asked to attend the week-long Rural Electric Washington Youth Tour program, which will be held in June. The tour includes approximately 70 students from across Kentucky and chaperones from Kentucky's electric cooperatives, as well as students from across the country.
